

Struck-By Flying Object

- Exist when something is being propelled, hurled or thrown:
 - Material separates from tool, machine or equipment and strikes worker
- Also created when using compressed air to clean surfaces and power tools



Preventing Workers from Being Pinned Between Objects

- Only allow workers needed in job areas where pinning hazards exist
- Proper bracing must be used for shoring in trenches
- Arrange the path of travel to avoid workers being caught-in or -between materials and moving equipment, and walls
